


#### Staff

Our Elementary School provides a superior educational environment steeped in Catholic tradition, providing an authentically Catholic experience while still catering to the diversity of our students and faculty. We are an accredited institution by the AdvancED North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI). All of our elementary teachers are state certified and undergo continuous professional development ensuring that our lesson plans and curriculum meets and exceeds state standards established for the public school system.

#### **Beyond the Basics**

Our school is unique in that we offer all of our students from Pre-K through sixth grade special classes which include: Technology, Art, Spanish, Music, Religion, Library and Physical Education. In addition, students in 3rd – 6th grade participate in weekly Health class and STREAM class (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Arts and Mathmatics) in our fully-equipped STREAM lab.



## The St. Jude Early Childhood Center

#### Philosophy

It is the philosophy of the Early Childhood Center at St. Jude the Apostle School that Pre-Kindergarten should be a time that encourages the social, emotional, physical, and intellectual growth and development of the child. Our program is theme-oriented which includes an Early Childhood Curriculum that is based on the alphabet and enables children to discover the joy of learning.

#### **Our Program Offerings**

Three(3) and Four(4) Year Old, Full and Half Day: AM and PM Classes:

- Half Day AM Classes: 8:00-11:00 Monday through Friday
- Half Day PM Classes: 11:30-2:30 Monday through Friday
- Full Day: 8:00-2:15 Monday through Friday

The following specials are provided to all Pre-K programs: Art, Technology, Library, Music, Physical Education and Spanish.

**Pre-K** (3) Curriculum: (must be 3 years old by Dec.1st) Children in the Pre-K (3) program are just beginning to experience school and being away from home. The Pre-K teachers encourage independence. Their goal is to teach the students to respect their classmates; their space; and their feelings. They believe that the most important thing for them to learn is that "school can be a great place to be!"

**Pre-K** (4) Curriculum: (must be 4 years old by Dec.1st) Pre-K is an exciting time in a young child's life. It is a time of new discovery, new friends, and new adjustments. Most of all, it is a time of learning. The Pre-K (4) program is aligned with the New York State Curriculum and Learning Standards, and is a wonderful time and important journey for your young child toward school readiness.

### Early Childhood Summer Program (Pre-K and Kindergarten)

The program is designed to combine the interests of children in Pre-K and Kindergarten with learning through discovery. The program takes a thematic approach to include a variety of educational and social experiences in a safe and creative environment. Held at St. Jude the Apostle School, our program is open to currently enrolled Pre-K and K students and those who will be enrolled by September, as well as those not currently enrolled. The Summer Program is staffed by teachers from Saint Jude the Apostle School, Day and After School Programs, who are experienced in educational and recreational programs.
